We will have tea at the Village Hall and their WCs will be available. Teas should be booked in advance through the secretary.

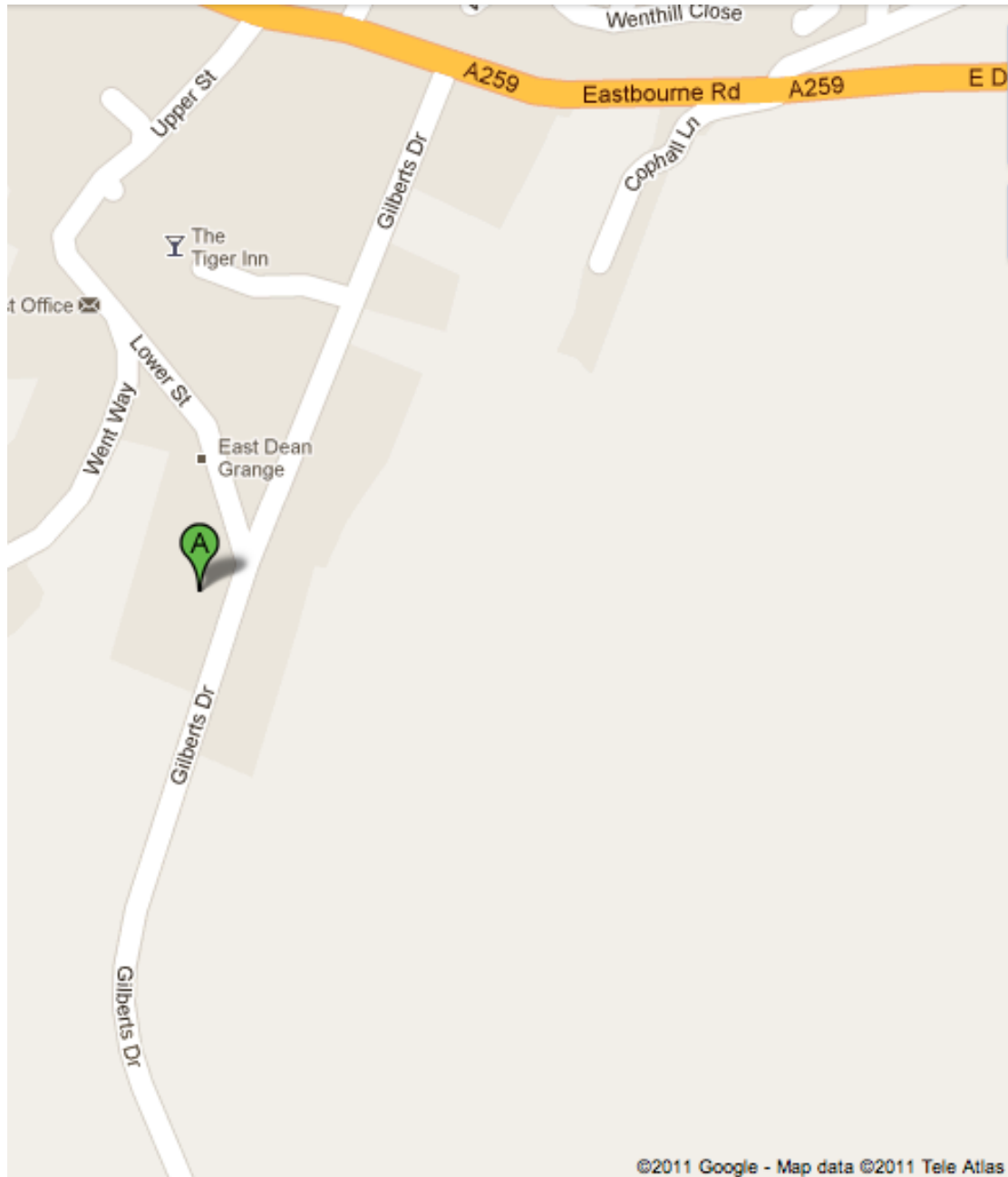
## **Please note:**

**East Dean – Village Hall indicated by marker ‘A’** The Ordnance Survey grid reference is TV557974



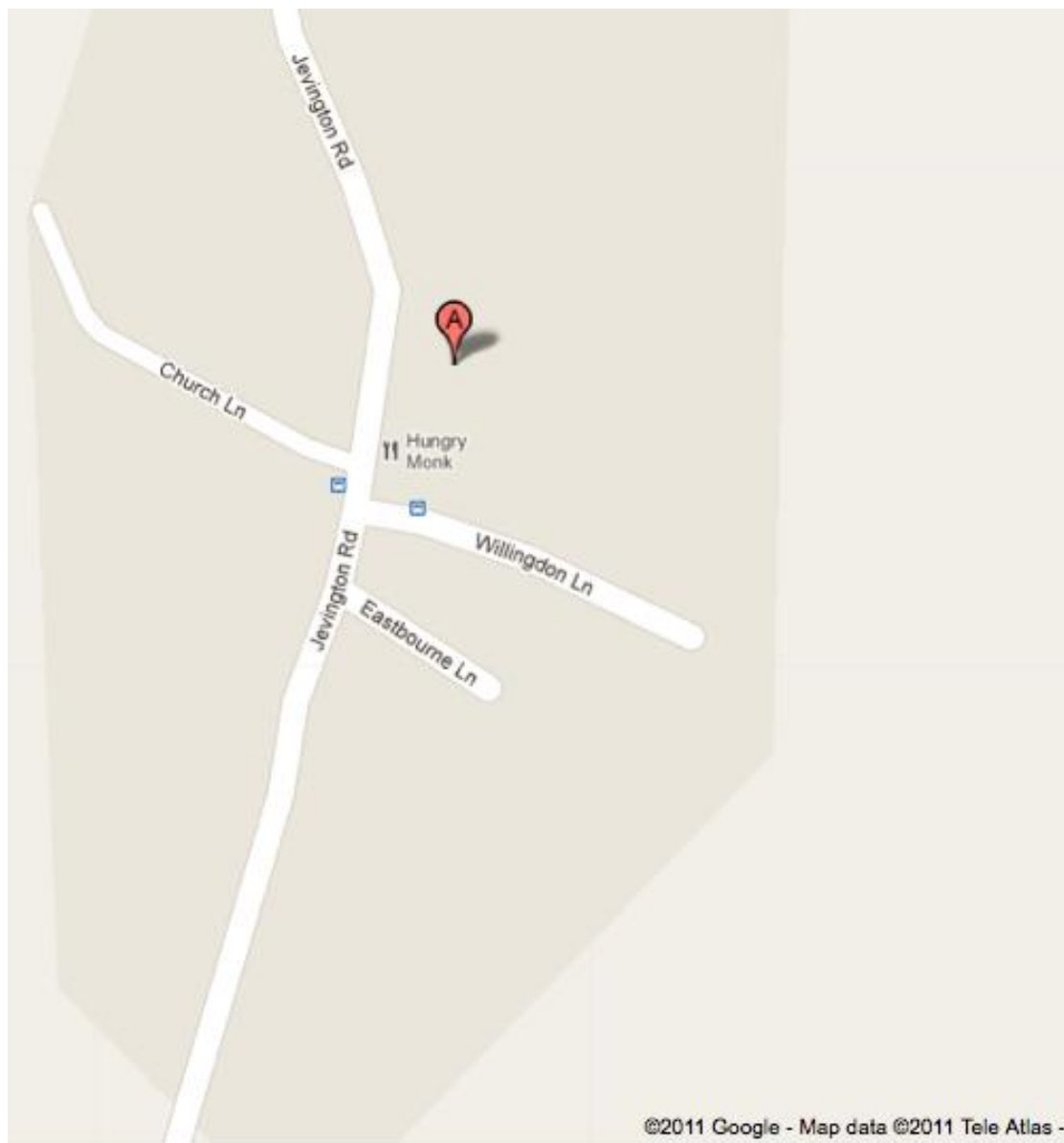
## JEVINGTON - PARKING

Access is from the A22 to the north (via Jevington Road) or for our purposes, directly from East Dean on the A259 coming on to Jevington Road from the bottom of the map.

The village car park is on the left hand side of Jevington Road before Eastbourne Lane.

St Andrews is at the top of Church Lane with adjacent very limited parking .

Marker 'A' is not significant for our visit.



There are about half a dozen spaces opposite the church but these are often filled by walkers and, with nowhere to turn, reversing down the, very narrow, Church Lane is something we avoid.

The car park off Jevington Road is about a quarter of a mile from the church. It holds about a dozen cars but is used by residents and, again, walkers.
